RAGGING IN ANY FORM WILL BE VIEWED SERIOUSLY. THE STUDENTS INDULGING IN RAGGING WILL BE DEALT WITH SERIOUSLY AND FOLLOWING ACTION CAN BE TAKEN AGAINST THEM :

- **SUSPENSION FROM ATTENDING CLASSES**
- **EXPULSION FROM HOSTEL**
- **DISMISSAL FROM COLLEGE**
- **REFUSAL OF ADMISSION IN ANY OTHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION**
- **DEBARRED FROM UNIVERSITY ENROLMENT**

APART FROM THE ABOVE, IF NECESSARY AND CIRCUMSTANCES WARRANT, THE PARENTS MAY BE ALLOWED **TO FILE F.I.R.** IN POLICE STATION FOR LEGAL ACTION UNDER LAW.

**CIRCULAR**

Sub: SVMC – Curbing the menace of ragging the Junior Students –  
Instructions issued.

Periodical instructions are received from Government of India, Medical Council of India and Pondicherry University that ragging of junior students in any form inside or outside the College Campus should be curbed. Ragging the Junior Students in all its forms is totally banned in this College/Hospital including its departments, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, Canteen etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. Any student is found involved in ragging the Junior Students, should be summarily expelled from the College.

It is, therefore, brought to the notice of all students that severe disciplinary action will be taken on those students involved in ragging the Junior Students in any form i.e. any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof to a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior Student.

As a watch and ward measure and to ensure that the Junior Students are not ill treated in the name of ragging, a standing committee is constituted under the Chairmanship of the Director and with other faculty members.

The students are advised not to involve themselves in any form of ragging and co-operate with the faculty and administration to curb this evil practice. The students are also advised to bring to the notice of the members of the Committee, if any untoward incident that has taken place inside or outside the college / hospital / hostels, for taking timely action and for averting the same.
